6. A book you have borrowed from a friend
7. A book with a question in the title
8. A story about a real-life adventure
9. A book you would recommend to a sibling
10. A book that relates to a current issue
11. Oliver Twist – in graphic, audio, eBook, or printed form.
12. A book with diary entries
13. A book by an author you have never read
14. A book with a female heroine
15. A book from the Premier's Reading Challenge booklist
16. A book from the fantasy genre
17. A book about an interest of yours – non-fiction / fiction
18. A book by a British author
19. A book containing two or more people on the cover
20. A book with a cover that features your favourite colour
21. A childhood favourite
22. A book by an Australian author
23. A mystery / detective or crime novel
24. A book from the YA (Young Adult Fiction) genre
25. A book recommended to you by a librarian
