
+ Mat you need + to know



As you complete a book, record the title / author and date of completion onto a reading record sheet available from the library, or keep your own records. This sheet must be presented to Mrs Rieger by **Week 5 Term 4** to be able to attend our end of year celebration.

You have two options to complete the challenge:

Commence challenge at GO. Roll your coloured dice and read books in the order that you land on a square. If when you roll, you land on a CHANCE square you must visit the library circulation desk to draw a CHANCE from the pile. Complete the mission and return the card to the pack. You do not need to do any more than 3 CHANCE card missions over the course of the challenge. You can choose to do more if you wish.

OR

- Read books from any categories in any order, record books on record form as you finish them.
- If you roll on a category that you have already read this calendar year, roll your dice again. Be sure to keep your reading record sheet up to date.

- At our end of year celebration there will be a **special prize draw** for people who have completed a minimum of **3 CHANCE cards across the challenge**.
- It is very easy (and very clever) to meet the requirements of the Premier's Challenge by using your reading from the 26BC. Speak with Ms Molloy or library staff to learn more. Learn more at: https://premiersreadingchallenge.sa.edu.au/

- Audio books, ebooks, graphic novels and books that you read in English class can be counted if they meet the category requirements.
